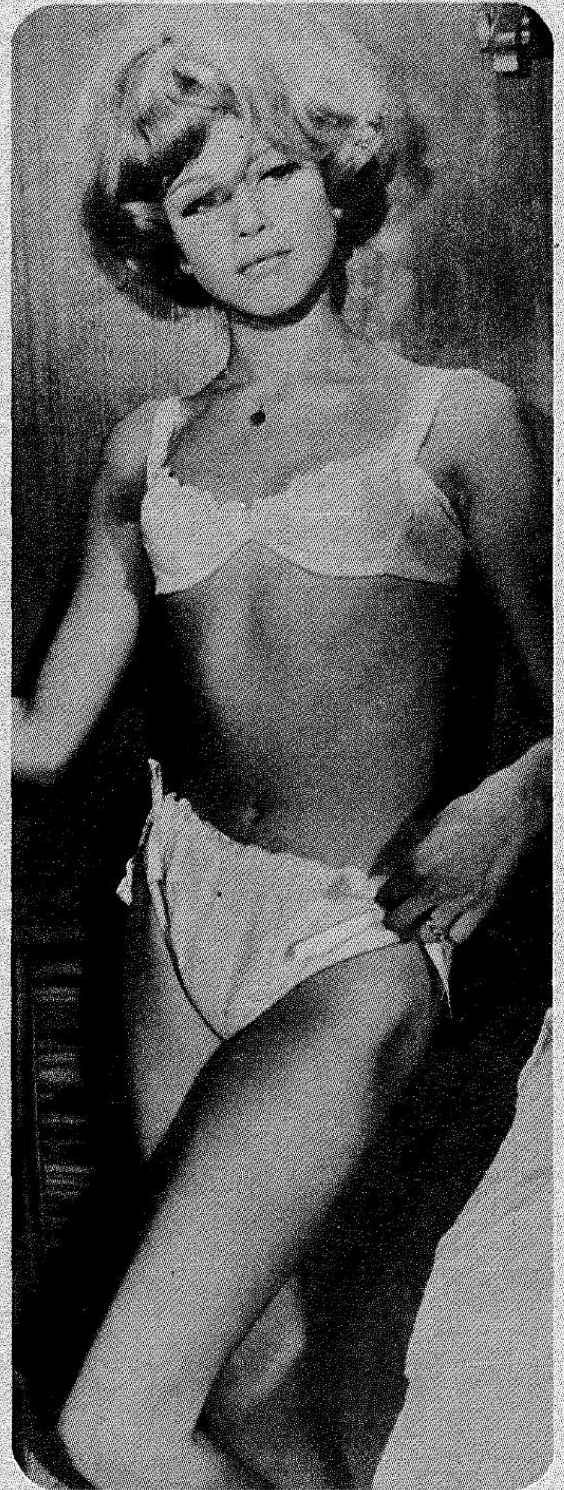




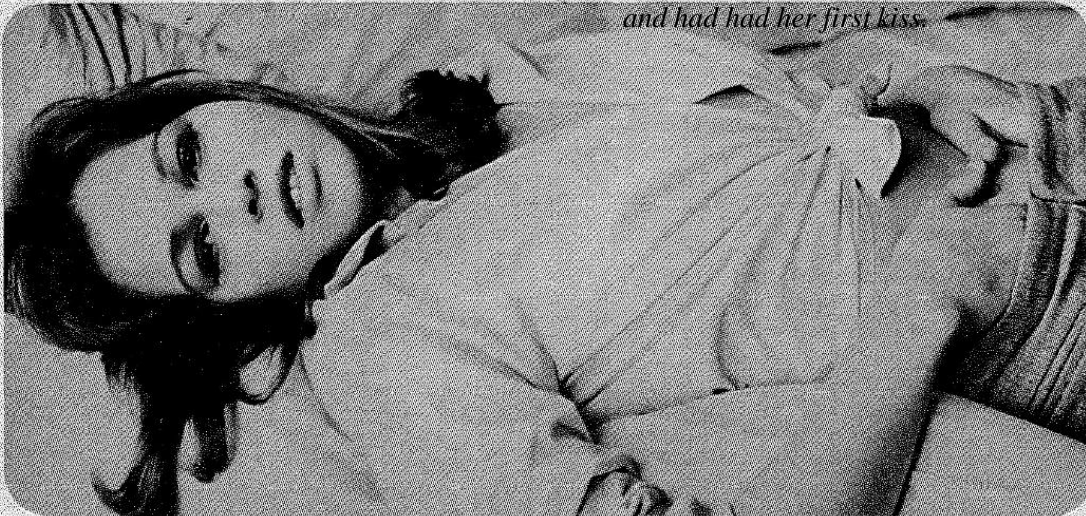
Helga at 18. During a walk in Hamburg, she caught a duck and had herself photographed with it. Roger had just met her.
